ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
98-1

WHEREAS, the justice system in Mohave County has recently experienced considerable growth in workloads, resource needs, and organizational and public demands; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a long-range plan to meet future court and justice-related agency needs in Mohave County; and

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Chief Justice Thomas A. Zlaket has encouraged courts to enhance community involvement and input through the establishment of local judicial advisory councils in each county;

IT IS ORDERED that the Mohave County Committee on the Justice System is established as follows:

1. PURPOSE:

The Committee shall serve as a forum to improve working relationships and communication among courts and justice-related agencies and departments. The Committee shall also be a mechanism to identify and effectively resolve issues of common interest that impact the justice system.

2. MEMBERSHIP:

The membership of the Committee is attached as an Appendix. The Chairman of the Committee may appoint additional members as necessary.


3. MEETINGS:

Meetings shall be scheduled at the discretion of the Committee Chairman.

4. STAFF:

The Court Administrator's Office shall provide staff support for the Committee and as feasible, may conduct or coordinate research as requested by the Committee.
